Position Overview:

The Ride for Refuge Coordinator works with the Resource Developer and the Director of Engagement to grow and implement the annual Ride for Refuge.

Organizational Overview:

The Kinbrace community welcomes refugee claimants with housing, education, and support. Located in Vancouver, BC, Kinbrace contributes to the welcome of refugee claimants across Canada.

The Kinbrace community is rooted in the Christian tradition, drawing its inspiration from the ancient summons to welcome those who are displaced, with radical generosity of spirit and space. We respond to this summons, guided by our core values of: Welcome, Trust, Mutual Transformation, Celebration and Prayer. We strive, as a diverse community, to work and act in ways that lead to justice and dignity for all people seeking refugee protection.

About the Kinbrace Ride for Refuge

The Kinbrace Ride for Refuge is the organization's annual signature walking/cycling event, happening each year the Saturday before Thanksgiving long weekend (next event: October 1, 2022). The Ride for Refuge is a family-friendly peer to peer national fundraising event orchestrated by the Blue Sea Foundation.

Kinbrace has participated in the Ride for Refuge since 2009. Prior to 2020, this event was a large event involving multiple charities taking part together. Since then Kinbrace has grown this event substantially by using a very flexible model during times of Covid restrictions. This year Kinbrace looks forward to hosting its first in-person event as a stand alone charity.

- Complete Vancouver special event permit application
- Organize and confirm any rentals needed
- Organize secure event bike storage
- Organize food/meal for event
- Plan and mark ride routes
- Organize and manage start and finish lines
- Lead the set up and take down with volunteers
- Confirm live music
- Provide a parking plan for event participants
- Organize emcee for event (if needed)
- Setup Kinbrace info tables inside and outside
- Setup a photo booth for participants
- Materials for bike decorations (compostable/biodegradable)
- Signage as needed
- Secure corporate sponsors
 - Set sponsorship levels
 - Design and distribute sponsorship packages (work with Kinbrace graphic designer)
 - Identify potential sponsors and categorize to sponsorship levels
 - Engage and invite corporate sponsors
 - Discern corporate sponsor's offer and Kinbrace's needs for the Ride event
 - Steward the relationships
 - Report back to sponsors after the event and confirm interest for the following year
