Position Overview:

Kinbrace is BC's longest-serving housing provider for refugee claimants, offering dedicated support and accessible educational resources across Canada in multiple languages. Kinbrace's Housing Program involves welcoming newly arrived refugee claimants into transitional housing at Kinbrace, followed by working alongside them to find dignified, affordable, permanent housing, somewhere in BC's Lower Mainland. Housing Volunteers will offer support to program participants as they search for and move into permanent housing.

Position Responsibilities:

Orientation and housing search:

- Help orient newcomers to the Lower Mainland
- Explore housing opportunities (by transit or car)
- Accompaniment to view housing opportunities

Help needed on moving days:

- Accompaniment with travel to new homes
- If able, lifting furniture in and out of trucks
- If able, drive U-Haul or Modo vehicle

Demonstrates strong privacy and confidentiality boundaries
Comfortable in interfaith settings
Proficiency in languages other than English an asset

Flexible number of days per month, and flexible number of hours per day

Requires travel to various locations in BC's Lower Mainland
Demonstrated commitment to the Kinbrace mandate (Mission, Vision, Core Values)

Provide a drivers' abstract to Kinbrace
